Frames

Text Frame

A text frame is a graphic object in which text is typed. A text frame can be moved, resized, and connected to other frames. When selected, they have small black squares called **handles**, which assist with moving and sizing.

Frames

Frames are used to contain text, pictures, tables, or graphics. Any frame can be resized or moved, and can also be used in layers. In addition, framed text can be wrapped around a framed object.

The advantage of using frames is that they can be resized, moved, wrapped, or layered.

Unlike in word processing, where all text and graphics are placed relative to margins, frames can be moved wherever you want in whatever size you choose.
