7. List the names of buildings owned by local/federal government entities.
8. How many buildings are currently owned by local, state, or federal government entities?
9. Who are the historical persons listed in the database?
10. What is the “lowest” recorded ID number in the database?
11. Which historical sites are privately owned and are listed in the historical register for the Queen Ann architectural style?
12. Which buildings were added to the historical register in 1993?
13. Which building is currently listed with a current function of recreation/culture with a secondary use as a museum?
14. How many historical buildings in the list are currently used as a hotel?
15. Which historical buildings have the word “**revival**” listed as a part of the architectural style?
